The Great Sphinx, Egypt.—This picture represents the great Gizeh, or great Sphinx, being one of a group of Sphinx that are supposed to be tombs and monuments of the great kings of Egypt. This particular Sphinx is 188 feet in length, and is hewn out of a natural eminence in the solid rock. Steps lead down to the front of this wonderful monument, where are sanctuaries and tablets of very ancient dates. At one time they were most imposing monuments, but centuries of changes have made a desert of a once wonderful place, and the Sphinx are partly submerged in sand.
