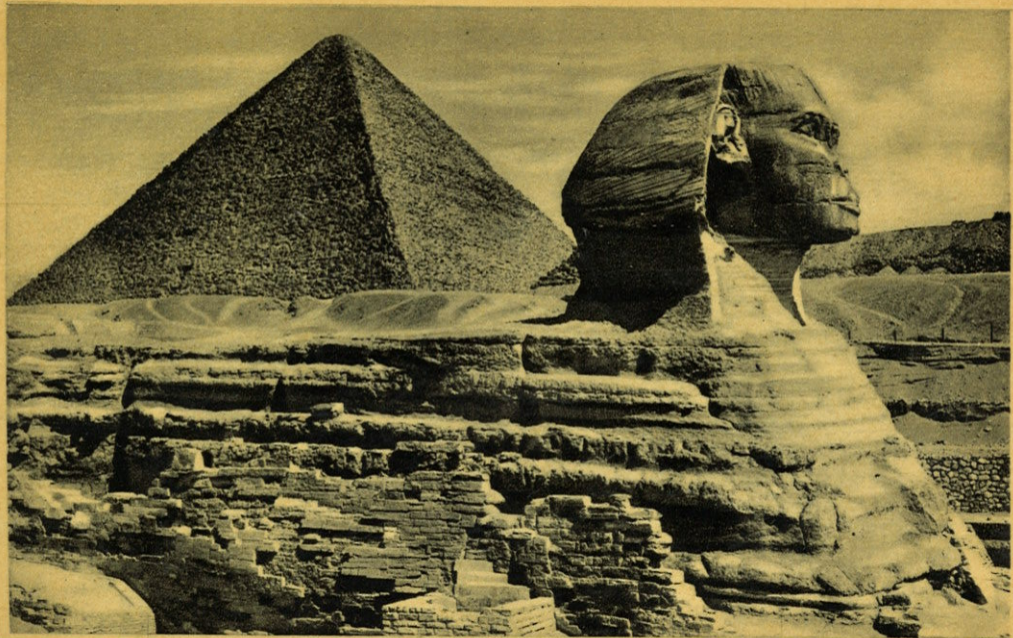

No. 404 CAIRO: The Sphinx at Giza. The oldest known monument in Egypt, reckoned among the greatest wonders of the world. Shaped from a mass of rock in the time of King Khephren, IV Dynasty 2850 B.C. It represents the head of the king with the body of a lion, protecting the 2nd Pyramid. In 1380 it was disfigured by a fanatical Sheikh.
